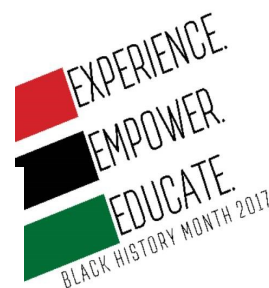
## Black History Month
