Attendance

Your attendance should be at least 95%. There are consequences to missing lessons:

If it drops below 90% your tutor will give you an 'attendance concern' with targets to improve your attendance to 95%.

If you fail these targets you will go on a Stage 1 attendance contract and will have to sign in at 8.45am EVERY DAY FOR THREE WEEKS.

If you fail this stage you will be put on Stage 2 and given 4 hours silent study per week for half a term.

If you fail this and are put on Stage 3 you will be given 8 hours silent study per week.

If you fail this and go onto Stage 4 you will be given two weeks to improve and then recommended to the Principal for PERMANENT EXCLUSION (two students have been asked to leave Woodhouse this term for poor attendance). There is a direct correlation between poor attendance and poor A level results – don't let this be you.
