### **Sanction for letting someone else in with your ID: stage 2 on the behaviour system.**

This applies if you hand your ID to them, or if you let them follow you through the gates.

## Heroes Wanted

Approximately over 28,500 children and adults every year face the devastating news that they have a blood cancer such as leukaemia. They rely on regular blood transfusions and for some, their only hope of survival is to receive a lifesaving racially-matched bone marrow donor.

When a black, mixed race person with blood cancer desperately needs a lifesaving transplant they have less than a 20% chance of finding the best possible match because there are far less people from these groups on the donor register. You can make a difference and maybe save someone's life by joining the register. Joining is simple, there are no needles or blood samples - just complete a short application form and give a cheek swab/saliva sample.
