




## Interested in Oxbridge?

## What Will You Do If You Were Mayor Of London?

Citizens UK is an alliance of schools, universities, faith groups and community groups who come together to campaign for change in our local communities. They are best known for starting the Living Wage Campaign, resettling Syrian refugees and campaigning to tackle youth violence. Their method believes that ordinary people, especially young people, can be trained to become leaders in their communities and agents for change. They build their campaigns based on the listening work they do with their members to identify issues. They are currently carrying out this 'Listening Campaign' in Barnet to understand what is angering local people and what people want changed. They are doing this listening to build a campaign in the lead up to the Elections for London Mayor in 2020 - so we can get the next Mayor to tackle our issues.
